

Sample Letter

On November of last year, Judge Cindy Lederman, struck down a 31-year old statute that bans homosexual adoption.

Timothy Osterhaus, the deputy solicitor general representing the state Department of Children & Families (DCF) urged the judges to focus on a relatively narrow legal question: whether the Legislature had a "rational basis" for the law because of risk factors among potential gay parents.

This case is currently in The Third District Court of Appeals of Florida. The Third District Court of Appeal will decide this year whether to allow two homosexual men to adopt these two children, or return the children to Foster Care.

Apparently Governor Crist did not get the memo about the pending gay adoption case in The Third District Court of Appeal of Florida and recently allowed his department of Child welfare to subsidize services for a teen adopted by a gay man.

Please write, email and call Governor Crist and remind him that Florida has a strict statute that prevents homosexuals from adopting children and that subsidies to children involved in a homosexual child custody case are not entitled to receive subsidies. Please ask the Governor and his cabinet to reverse this recent decision.
